Project Directory & File Structure

 As we know every web enabled project has a root folder so here we are going to show only the directory structure which is vary necessary for both front-end developer as well as backend developer.




1) Naming Convention

- No spaces allowed in directory and file names.
- Only '-' symbol allowed for directory and file name if there is multiple words.
- All letters of directory and file name must in lowercase letter.

 Note – The above rules you can break only for critical situations such as for server configuration, special hidden files etc. but not for common directory and file name structure.

Description

- Basically every web project we use HTML for structuring the document, CSS for presentation of document and JavaScript to handle user interaction and these things are the heart of web project so we want to follow the above same directory structure.
- In project root directory there is a 'media' directory and which contains css, images, and js files with specified directory.
